#### THE JUDGMENT OF GOD (PART 3 OF 4)

*God justifies the ungodly:* not on account of their works but on account of Christ's perfect work; not for their merits, but purely through the free and undeserved gift of his grace; not a status they accomplish, but something they receive through faith. This is the famous doctrine of justification *propter solum Christum, sola gratia, sola fide*, on account of Christ alone, by grace alone, through faith alone.

This denial of justification by works was not a denial of good works. In the teaching of the Reformers the doctrine of justification by faith *apart* from works is inseparably united to the doctrine of sanctification *in* good works which are the fruit of a lively faith. As in justification the perfect righteousness of Christ is imputed to us and received through faith, so in sanctification Christian righteousness (necessarily imperfect) is progressively infused in us, as faith, hope, charity, and the other virtues. As the righteousness of justification is alien or extrinsic (outside us), so the righteousness of sanctification is inherent (in us). The inseparable union of the two distinct kinds of righteousness is known in this fact, that the faith through which man is justified is an infused virtue

of his sanctification, whereas the works in which he is sanctified are the necessary fruit of his justification through faith.

The Christian thus exists simultaneously in two realms, both heaven and earth, as one who is simultaneously righteous and a sinner (*simul justus et peccator*). On the one hand he is in heaven, as one whom God has reckoned perfectly righteous in Christ, a status known by faith alone ("our life is hid with Christ in God"). On the other hand he is a sinner still in earth, engaged in the struggle to grow in holiness, putting vice to death and rising again to virtue, through good works of repentance and amendment of life, serving his neighbour in love, bearing the cross in patience and humility, acting in obedience to God's commands, following the example of the saints, making use of all the means of grace especially the Word and Sacraments. On this feast of St. Michael and All Angels, in virtue of Christ's righteousness we are with the angels in heaven, as they worship and adore the most Holy Lord, but in
